

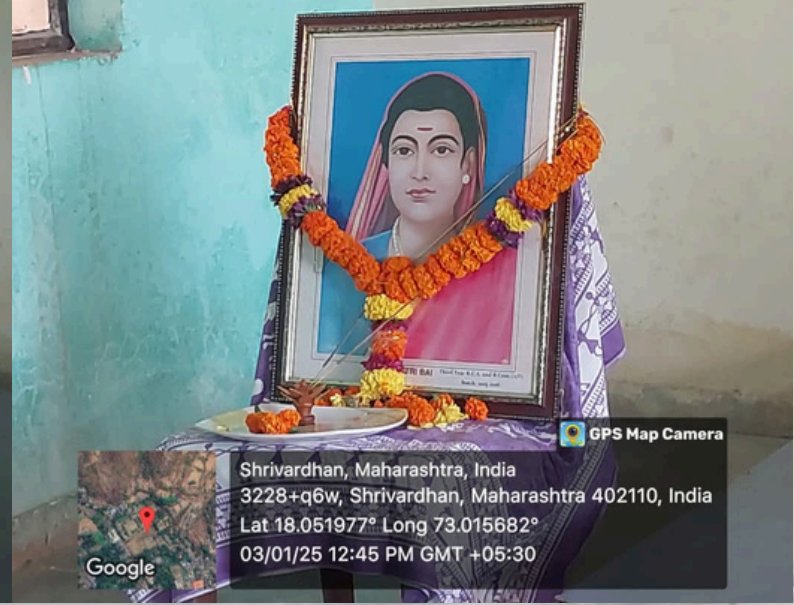

If a woman feels injustice at the hands of her superiors in a workplace, she can seek redress in the court. According to the Domestic Violence Act, a criminal gets investigated and punished by laws. Shrivardhan Taluka Vidhi Seva Samiti is ready to provide legal help to the children and the elderly.'

The proposal of the program was done by Dr. Yogesh Lokhande and Adv. Santosh Sapate. The program was coordinated by Adv. Vithoba Patil. Adv. Atul Chaugule gave detailed guidance about Female violence act 2013 at work place. Adv. Shailesh Chandorkar guided regarding road safety and traffic signs rules. Adv. Tania Gandhi introduces about Protection of Children from Sexual Offenses Bill, 2011.
